I have put away sharp objects such as scissors, letter openers, tweezers, etc.
I have checked every room for houseplants that could be eaten and cause illness.
I have chosen appropriate locks for different types of windows and cabinets.
I have covered the thermostat.
I have installed smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors in or near the kitchen and all sleeping areas.
I have hidden a spare house key outside in case my loved one accidentally locks me out of the house.
I have removed or secured all guns or other weapons.
I have restricted access to the computer and Internet or set appropriate software to screen for objectionable material.
